CALL YOUR ATTENTION TO AN IMPOSSIBLE SITUATION THAT HAS BEEN CREATED

BY THE SUDDEN WITHDRAWAL YESTERDAY BY OUR INSURANCE CARRIER OF OUR

LIABILITY INSURANCE ON VACCINES TO BE PRODUCED FOR YOUR SWINE FLU

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KPROGRAM.

OUR COMPANY IS MORE THAN WILLING TO PRODUCE THE VACCINE FOR THE

GOVERNMENT PROGRAM. HOWEVER, WE ARE PLACED IN AN UNTENABLE POSITION WHEN WE ARE REQUESTED TO SUPPLY INFLUENZA VACCINE TO BE USED IN A MASS IMMUNIZATION PROGRAM WITHOUT ANY INSURANCE COVERAGE OR OTHER LIABILITY PROTECTION.

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PARKE-DAVIS HAS PRODUCED QUALITY VACCINE FOR YEARS AND WILL CONTINUE TO DO SO. HOWEVER, IT IS RECOGNIZED BY MEDICAL EXPERTS THAT IN A MASS IMMUNIZATION PROGRAM COVERING ALL SEGMENTS OF THE POLULATION--YOUNG, OLD, SICK AND WELL--THAT DIFFERENT REACTIONS MAY BE EXPECTED. FOR THE VAST MAJORITY IT CANN BE ANTICIPATED WITH CERTAINTY THAT COMPLETE PROTECTION WITH MINOR OR NO SIDE EFFECTS WILL RESULT. OTHERS, HOWEVER, MAY OBTAIN LESS THAN FULL PROTECTION AND OTHERS MAY HAVE MORE SEVERE SIDE EFFECTS.

S YOU KNOW, VACCINATIONS ARE USUALLY GIVEN IN A DOCTORS'S OFFICE WHERE THE PERSON AND HIS OR HER GENERAL HEALTH SITUATION IS KNOWN TO THE DOCTOR AND THE CONDITIONS UNDER WHICH IT IS GIVEN ARE CONTROLLED. IN ADDITION, EACH PERSON CAN BE FULLY INFORMED OF AKE ASPECTS OF THE INNOCULATION AND IN GENERAL WHAT TO EXPECT.

IN A MASS IMMUNIZATION PROGRAM THIS IS HIGHLY IMPROBABLE OR IMPOSSIBLE OF ACCOMPLISHMENT. AS A RESULT LESS THAN FULLY PROTECTION FROM ILLNESS, GREATER SIDE EFFECTS THAN ANTICIPATED OR EVEN A SUBSEQUENT UNRELATED ILLNESS MAY BE CONSIDERED IN THE MINDS OF SOME AS A BASIS FOR A LIABILITY SUIT AGAINST THE COMPANY. SUCH SUITS WOULD BE EXTREMELY COSTLY EVEN IF SUCCESSFULLY DEFENDED AND COULD HAVE UNCERTAIN OUTCOMES FOR YEARS.

SINCE THERE NOW APPEARS TO BE NO OTHER SOURCE FOR SUCH SPREADING OF THE RISK AS IS ACCOMPLISHED BY INSURANCE, WE EARNESTLY REQUEST YOU TO SUPPORT OR SPONSOR LEGISLATION WILL ENABLE HEW OR ANY OTHER APPROPRIATE ARM OF THE GOVERNMENT TO PROMPTLY REPLACE OUR INSURANCE COVERAGE THAT WILL BE CANCELLED JULY 1.

AGAIN WE WANT TO ASSURE YOU THAT OUR COMPANY IS MOST DESIROUS OF

SUPPORTING YOUR PROGRAM AND THAT WE ARE CONTINUING TO PRODUCE VACCINE AND HAVE TODAY SUBMITTED A BID AS REQUESTED BY HEW, SUBJECT TO RESOLUTION OF THIS PROBLEM BEFORE OUR INSURANCE COVERAGE IS WITHDRAWN ON JULY 1.

WE ARE CONFIDENT THAT YOU AND THE CONGRESS AND THE AMERICAN PEOPLE WILL RECOGNIZE AND RESOLVE THIS DIFFICULT SITUATION IN WHICH OUR COMPANY AND ITS STOCKHOLDERS HAVE BEEN PLACED DUE TO CIRCUMSTANCES BEYOND OUR CONTROL

Dear Mr. Giblin:

I am writing on behalf of the President about your communication to provide indemnification against claims for injury related to inoculation with vaccine under a comprehensive nationwide influenza immunization program.

As you know the Secretary of Health, Education and Welfare has submitted legislation to agree, in contracts for the purchase of vaccine in connection with the Sational Influenza Immunization Program to indemnify the vaccine manufacturers against claims attituable to inoculation with the vaccine, except claims arising out of the negligence of the manufacturers. Hearings are beingh held by the Congress and final action is expected soon by both bodies.
