

contract of approximately \$20 million to build an experimental
flight research aircraft aimed at developing technology to
reduce aircraft noise impact on U.S. communities and
congestion at major airports.

Boeing will modify a government-furnished deHavilland C-8
Buffalo transport aircraft into a quiet short-haul research
aircraft to be used in a flight research program at NASA's
Ames Research Center, Mountain View, CA. The Government is
also furnishing four AVCO - Lycoming YF-102 turbofan engines
for the aircraft.

The research objective of the quiet short-haul research aircraft (QSAR) program will contribute to a technology data base needed to establish design and certification criteria and operational procedures and techniques for future quiet propulsive-lift short-haul aircraft.
