

Clothing for pre-school through high school age children is needed. The clothing will go to the Children's Boutique, 2728 Sherman Avenue, N. W., where children and parents will be able to select from racks in a store-like setting.

There will be pick-up boxes in the following locations:

East Wing Basement (outside East Wing Messenger's office)

West Wing Basement (ground floor entrance, West Executive Avenue)

OEOB Ground Floor (near Cafeteria)

OEOB First Floor (north entrance hallway, Pennsylvania Avenue)

Although we will have the boxes up until Christmas, the drive will officially conclude on December 13, 1975.
