



Dear Jerry,


Hope you and/or your wife

DIRECTIONS TO TAPPAN HILL RESTAURANT

1. From NYC: Take NYS Thruway (Rt. 87) to exit 9, right turn at exit stop sign (Rt. 119), proceed to first traffic light then make left turn onto Benedict Ave., travel 3 lights, make right at 3rd light, Highland Ave.), go to stop sign on Highland, Restaurant driveway entrance will be on left at intersection.
2. From CONN.: Via Rt. 287, (Cross Westchester Expressway), take Rt. 287 to exit 1, exit ramp will direct you into correct direction on Rt. 119, go to first traffic light, make right turn, — now on Benedict Ave., travel 3 lights, make right turn at 3rd light — now on Highland Ave., go to first stop sign — Restaurant driveway entrance will be on left at this intersection.
3. 
