SUBJECT: Wayne Hays/Ohio Trip

I spoke to Wayne Hays about accompanying you to Ohio State or returning with you subject to his own schedule. He was most grateful for your thoughtfulness but advised that he was in Ohio and had accepted an invitation to cut a ribbon dedicating a new highway at 11:00 o'clock on that day. He indicated he would try to cancel but I gathered it was going to cause him severe difficulties and, therefore, did not encourage it.

// He said he wants to talk to you quite soon about the Election Reform Bill, and get your views as to what you will or will not sign before he goes to conference. He wanted you to know that he does not want to go beyond House action on this matter.

I told him I was sure that you would want to get with him and you may wish to have Bill Timmons and Max Friedersdorf set something up. Wayne has been dealing with Max on this.


