It is my understanding that the current Chairman of the Republican National Finance Committee, David K. (Pat) Wilson of Nashville, Tennessee, has been recommended to Governor Scranton as a appropriate candidate for a Cabinet level assignment.

Although I have no information as to that potential, you should also be aware that Pat has privately talked with me and appropriate members of my staff about his very real interest in an ambassadorial assignment. He is particularly interested in the South African post, currently occupied by Non-Career Officer John Hurd, but available by virtue of Hurd's stated desire to leave as quickly as a successor can be appointed.

Obviously a Cabinet assignment would be preferable to Pat; however, should that not be an option, Wilson's appointment as Ambassador to South Africa would be, if appropriate, an alternative welcomed by him.
