Secretary Jim Schlesinger called this morning to suggest, if possible, you ask Chairman John Stennis into your office after this morning's meeting for a very brief chat on the Defense Appropriations bill. The conference meets today and McClellan is planning to give back \$600 million but Schlesinger wants \$800-1,000 million restored.

Jim argues inflation has hurt DOD and that the Soviets may test the new President and now is not the time to give them a false signal.
