Subject: Consumer Price Index for August

M

The Consumer Price Index (CPI) rose 1.3 percent in August on a seasonally adjusted basis, the largest monthly increase since August 1973 and the second largest since during the Korean War. All major categories of the CPI -- food, nonfood commodities and services -- contributed relatively equally to the advance. The attached table shows the growing pervasiveness of inflation as price increases for food and energy have slowed over the past six months, while price increases for other goods and services have accelerated.

Supplementary Material

Apparel prices, which have risen more slowly during the past year than the overall CPI, spurted 2.6 percent last month. The August rise in mortgage interest rates, as measured in the CPI, brought them to a level 16.7 percent above a year earlier. The medical care services component of the CPI advanced 1.6 percent in August; in the four months since the end of controls, it has risen at an annual rate of 19.3 percent.
