Summary

While it remains true to the present that the recent rates of increase in the narrowly defined money supply (M_1) and also in the broadly defined money supply (M_2) are appreciably smaller than the average rates of increase over the past 52 weeks, there are now several signs of an easing of pressures in financial markets (see optional reading).
