In the attached memorandum of October 19, 1974, Secretary Kissinger indicates your decision to nominate Frank C. Carlucci as Ambassador to Portugal (Tab A). This memorandum seeks confirmation of that decision in order that I may undertake those steps necessary to effect this nomination.

Carlucci serves as Under Secretary of HEW, but has retained his status as a Foreign Service Officer and was recently accorded the rank of Career Minister (Tab B). He would succeed Stuart Nash Scott, a non-career officer, who has served in Lisbon since December 1973.
