WHEN: Thursday, January 16, 1975

BACKGROUND: 1. Chairman Eastland, Senator Roman Hruska (R-NEB),
and Ed Levi, attended a breakfast meeting Tuesday,
January 14, to discuss Levi's nomination by the
President as Attorney General.

2. At the conclusion of the meeting, Senator Eastland
agreed it would be desirable for the President to
submit the Levi nomination on the opening of the
Congress.

TALKING POINTS:

1. Senator, it was kind of you to meet with Ed Levi
this week and I appreciate your approval of my
submitting his name on the first day of the 94th
Congress.

2. Bill Saxbe intends to leave by February 3, and I
am hopeful we can fill this post as soon as
possible.

3. We will work with you on expediting this nomination
and will cooperate to the fullest extent in your
hearings and consideration of the nomination.
