- 7:55 Remove plates.
- 8:00 INAUGURATION. President Borman's farewell address. He introduces new Alfalfa president, Senator Hubert H. Humphrey.
- 8:10 Immediately, Sgt. Michael Ryan sings, "For He's Our President."
- 8:12 ACCEPTANCE SPEECH by President Humphrey. (Note: These are brief (5 minutes) witty, seemingly extemporaneous remarks, commenting on how little President Borman has done for Alfalfa in his year as president, and what grandiose plans Sen. Humphrey has for Alfalfa during his term. All in fun!)

- 9:00 INITIATION. Rep. James Symington, on stage, after recognition by President Humphrey initiates new members. President Humphrey welcomes new members and announces that Sgt. Michael Ryan will serenade with "Come to the Land of Alfalfa" as they return to their seats.
- 9:30 Serve champagne, dessert and coffee.
Immediately, Toast to the President of the United States.
- 9:45 CONVENTION. President Humphrey temporarily recesses dinner, recognizes Alfalfa Member, (coming) to offer RESOLUTION nominating Alfalfa's Candidate for President of the United States.
(Justice Stewart)
- 9:50 CANDIDATE'S ACCEPTANCE SPEECH. President Humphrey responds briefly.
(Ambassador George Bush)
- 0:20 President Humphrey thanks ASCAP for arranging professional program. Introduces singer, Miss Barbara Shuttleworth.
- 0:45 President Humphrey thanks artist.
- 0:47 President Humphrey introduces ranking guest (President, Vice President, or Chief Justice). At conclusion of his remarks, President Humphrey thanks organizers and adjourns dinner.
