Anticipated Problem Areas

The Domestic Council staff is undertaking a review of various trends and possible events in 1975 which may require Administration action or reaction. Hopefully, proper identification and planning now will enable us to better address situations as they arise.

By way of example, continued high unemployment by ghetto youth this summer may well result in sporadic violence or worse. Similarly, next September may well bring Court ordered busing to other northern cities.

Out of this review will come a series of informational memos for your review on potential problem areas. In most cases we will not be recommending any course of Federal action but simply providing an early warning of a problem area that may require attention six months from now.
