MEMORANDUM FOR: JIM CONNOR
FROM: DON RUMSFELD

I have talked to John Dunlop. I told him that the issue on Usery being a special assistant or something ought to be resolved fast -- that the President wanted to meet with Usery on Friday or Saturday.

My suggestion is that you set up the Usery meeting at the end of the Dunlop meeting. Make sure that the President resolves the question of Usery's title in the Dunlop meeting, and then they would go right into the Usery meeting.
