"The report that General Haig had admitted that the United
States had secret understandings with South Vietnamese President
Thieu in 1973 when President Thieu agreed to sign the Paris
peace accords is not true. On Thursday, March 27, General
Haig addressed a joint gathering of two service schools in
Washington, D. C. During his presentation, he made no
reference whatsoever to secret agreements with President
Thieu. His presentation was fully consistent with the White
House statement issued on April 9."
