MEMORANDUM TO DONALD RUMSFELD

Subject: Potential vetoes

The attached material responds to your request for a list of potential vetoes during this session of the Congress.

A few obvious cautionary notes are in order:

- It is not feasible to predict with certainty whether many of the bills on the list will in fact be enacted and whether some of them will be sufficiently revised during the legislative process to meet Administration objections so as to avoid a veto.
- The timing of their enactment is in most cases a best guess.
- As we move through this session, other bills deserving veto consideration but not identifiable now will undoubtedly become active in the Congress.
