The Greek Ambassador, Mr. Menelas Alexandrakis made the following statement today:

"Representative Don Edwards of California brought to my attention that at today's breakfast at the White House he, as well as other members, received the definite impression that the Greek government does not oppose the resumption of military supplies at this time by the United States to Turkey.

I am authorized to state clearly that if such representations were made they are absolutely erroneous and contrary to the well-known views of the Greek government."
