By memorandum of September 19, 1975, I designated a group specifically responsible for coordinating our response to matters dealing with the intelligence community. I further designated Jack Marsh as Chairman.

The purpose of this memorandum is to add Brent Scowcroft as a permanent member of the group and assign this group responsibility for developing, for my consideration, legislative recommendations concerning the organization and functioning of foreign intelligence activities by the United States.

Decision papers containing legislative alternatives should be prepared for me in time for my consideration prior to the return of Congress following the Christmas recess.
