Mrs. Lampe is the new President of the Virginia Federation of Republican Women and is an extremely able lady. She is a long time friend of former Congressman Joel Broyhill. She ran several of his campaigns. She did not manage his campaign in '74 when he lost. Mrs. Lampe's husband, who is a stockbrocker, spoke in favor of the Reagan forces during the 10th District Convention. She is reportedly upset because no Ford leadership contacted her during the pre-convention campaign in Virginia. She calls herself uncommitted, bur reportedly is leaning towards Reagan.
