Preesident, and it was on this assurance that he was elected a  
delegate from Delaware, he has since announced that he is uncommitted.

His wife works for Senator Bill Roth who has spoken to him  
and also sent him a letter to be delivered here in Kansas City.

Nevertheless, every signal is that he is philosophically and  
mentally ready to switch to Reagan.

A Visit with the President could be helpful in either keeping him  
uncommitted until it is clear in his mind that the President has the votes  
and therefore why not go along, or switch him to the President.
