In addition to these expiring laws, a number of additional powers now exercised by the Executive Branch will expire on September 14, 1978. This occurs because on that date the National Emergencies Act (P.L. 94-412) terminates almost all declarations of national emergency now in force, and a number of powers now conferred on the Executive Branch are contingent upon the existence of a declaration of national emergency. Early in 1977 instructions will be sent to all agencies requiring them to submit (1) a list of any currently exercised authorities which will be affected by the National Emergencies Act and (2) draft legislation for the continuance of any of these authorities which are deemed necessary.
