THE UNFORTUNATE PART OF THIS REPETITION IS THAT WE BECOME INURED TO THE FACT THAT THERE IS A CRISIS AND THAT UNLESS SOMETHING IS DONE, AND DONE SOON, OUR CITIES WILL NO LONGER BE CENTERS OF CULTURE AND COMMERCE BUT WILL BECOME CESSPOOLS OF CRIME AND CORRUPTION -- HOLDING DOWN AMERICA'S PROGRESS RATHER THAN FURTHERING IT.

UNTIL THE LEADERS OF OUR NATION, AND THIS MEANS PRIMARILY YOU, THE

COLLEGE TRAINED MEN AND WOMEN, BECOME SUFFICIENTLY AROUSED TO DO SOMETHING

ABOUT THESE PROBLEMS, THE PROBLEMS WILL CONTINUE TO GROW UNCHECKED. IT IS

IN 1966, ALONE, 2,810 CRIMES WERE REPORTED. HOW MANY OTHERS WERE NOT
