SUBJECT: SYNFUELS LEGISLATIVE AFFAIRS MEETING

It now looks as though the synfuels bill, H.R. 12112, may be brought to the House Floor sometime next week. The bill is extremely complicated -- it was sequentially referred to four committees -- and is extremely controversial.

In order for the Administration spokesmen to be effective in expressing the Administration's view on this legislation -- and to give the White House effort the visibility the Chairman and Ranking Member of HS&T desire -- it is requested that your office set up a briefing and "target assignment session" for the Congressional Relations officers of the appropriate agencies and Departments.

We are prepared to provide a not-to-exceed 15 minute substantive brief on the purposes of the bill, a preliminary head-count on the House Members' positions, and a concise set of Fact Sheets, argument papers, etc. for use by the participants and their principals. We can go with anything up to an hour's advance notice, but I suggest that some time be scheduled as soon as possible to ensure full attendance by the senior IA officers concerned.
