MY SPECIAL THANKS GO TO MARY LOUISE SMITH. EDDIE MAHE (MYY) AND TO THE FIVE VERY CAPABLE LADIES WHO WERE INSTRUMENTAL IN THE DRAMATIC SUCCESS OF THE CONFERENCE -- KIT DONAHUE (DONNA-HUE), JACKIE NYSTROM (NYE-STRUM), CATHY BERTINI (BER-TEENIE), JANE GRIGOR (GRIGG-ER) AND CHERYL JACKSON.
