LEWISTON, MAINE (UPI) -- MICHAEL FORD, THE PRESIDENT'S OLDEST SON, SAID MONDAY SOME MATTERS HAD RECEIVED MORE ATTENTION THAN THEY DESERVED DURING THE CAMPAIGN.

IN A BRIEF INTERVIEW BETWEEN CAMPAIGN STOPS, HE SAID TOO MUCH HAD BEEN MADE OF EVENTS LIKE THE PLAYBOY INTERVIEW AND THE RESIGNATION OF AGRICULTURE SECRETARY EARL BUTZ.

"CRUCIAL ISSUES LIKE TAX BREAKS FOR THE WORKING MAN, DEFENSE AND PERSONAL INTEGRITY HAVEN'T BEEN GIVEN THE ATTENTION THEY DESERVE," HE SAID. "MUCH OF THE CAMPAIGN HAS BEEN A NONISSUE CAMPAIGN; I THINK IT'S UNFORTUNATE."

FORD SAID HE BLAMED MEMBERS OF BOTH POLITICAL PARTIES FOR THAT AND SAID HE WAS REASSURED TO SEE ISSUES COMING TO THE FORE IN RECENT WEEKS.
