First Lady Betty Ford arrived in Southern California for two days of campaigning Tuesday—and spent part of the afternoon telephoning people who just didn't believe they were talking to President Ford's wife. "They just don't believe it's me," she laughed, hanging up the phone after her second call of the afternoon to seek votes for her husband. "I tell them I'm Betty Ford and they tell me I'm kidding...!"

Mrs. Ford arrived at Long Beach Municipal Airport aboard an Air Force DC-9 and was greeted by about 150 well-wishers from local Republican clubs and her son, Steve, who drove her to Republican campaign headquarters in Downey in his mobile home.
