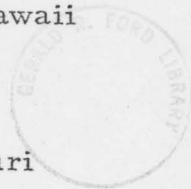

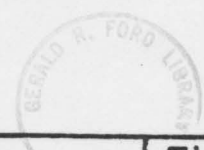

Senators Baker and Pearson have requested that you switch the nominations to the Corporation for Public Broadcasting by appointing Mr. Charles Roll, Republican of New Jersey (recommended by Senator Baker), to replace Jack Wrather of California instead of Thomas Moore of Connecticut both of whose terms have expired on the Corporation and neither of whom have been reappointed. Senator Pastore will not hold hearings and confirm either of the individuals recommended by Senators Pearson or Baker unless Moore remains on the Board as he will continue to serve until a new nominee is confirmed for his position.

I checked with Leon Parma as to whether it would be appropriate to explain this to Wrather and secure his agreement. I understand that Wrather does not wish to be reappointed and Parma thought that from a California political standpoint this would not be a problem.

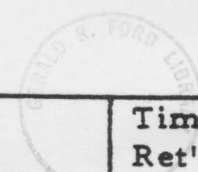
