I understand (primarily from the newspapers) that Stu Spencer and Peter Kaye intend to launch an attack on Reagan's record as Governor as part of our California Primary strategy.

I have been advised from several very good California sources that this could be a big mistake.

I don't want to second guess Stu, but I think this should be thought through carefully.

In any event, I do not think that any outside Ford "advocates" should go into California and attack Reagan. Any criticism of his record as Governor should come from Californians, such as State and local officials who held office while Reagan was Governor.

In the meantime -- pending any further guidance from you -- I have advised Warren Hendriks to make certain that Administration spokesmen being sent into California through the Hendriks operation be advised that they should stress the President's positive record of accomplishments and not engage in Reagan attacks.

Supervisor Mikesell attended the May 5th signing ceremony of the Federal Aid Highway Act of 1976. During that ceremony, he had an opportunity to meet with the President and have a picture taken. He has subsequently given wide publicity in his local jurisdiction to his meeting with the President at the signing ceremony.

- The incumbency is a strong factor among conservative Republicans and should be emphasized.
- * 3. Telephone banks should concentrate heavily on the Beach areas where Republican young and moderate voters live.

Ford is popular with the over 65's. Specific telephoning to this group will help the President's turnout. Many liked the social security discussion that was used in Florida.

4. Avoid attacking Reagan's Republican credentials. Advocates could bring up Reagan signing of ERA Amendment and the trust/honesty issue. Also the state tax issue.
