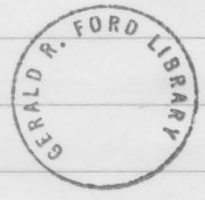

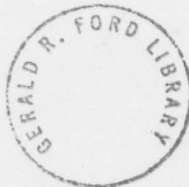

To follow-up on our phone conversation of this afternoon, I am sending the mailing address for Mrs. J. A. Pritzker.

Last fall, Mr. and Mrs. Pritzker visited the Peoples Republic Of China. As a result of that visit, Mrs. Pritzker and her four children have been invited to visit the Peoples Republic from August 13th through August 27th of this year. They are presently scheduled to arrive in Peking on the 13th and leave via Hong Kong on the 27th. Mrs. Pritzker has been informed that they will be allowed to visit six cities--but as is typical, they have no idea as to which cities!

It will be most helpful and I should add comforting, for the Pritzker family to know that the American authorities in the Peking Liaison Office are aware of their visit should any direct communications become necessary. Therefore, as we discussed, if you and/or Brent Scowcroft could advise Ambassador Gates as to the dates Mrs. Pritzker and her children will be in the Peoples Republic Of China, it would be most appreciated.
