SUBJECT: Mondale

Mondale authored the Child & Family Services Act that resulted in one of the biggest deluges of protest mail on the Hill in recent years.

The bill was perceived as a mandatory child care program that virtually took children away from homes and stuck them in day care centers.

I have alerted Duval to this and he is starting the research.

Mondale's rating on ACA has been zero and 100% ADA. Although not altogether perceived publicly, Mondale is more liberal than even Church or Kennedy.
