SUBJECT: Presidential Schedule Events
Relating to National Security *↙*

Dick, our group the other day came up with the following suggestions for Presidential schedule items which tie him closely to the national security issue.

We would like to submit these to you for the President's general conceptual signoff.

The events are as follows:

- Major defense/national security speech before the Daughters of the American Revolution. - Approved.
- View the Air Force B-1 bomber while in California before the primary. Relates to jobs and national defense.
- Spend the night off the East Coast on a Navy carrier as part of a Naval exercise.
- Make a major Armed Forces Day appearance at a location such as Ft. Campbell, Kentucky. This ties in with conventional forces and the volunteer Army. May 15 - good primary stop.
- Dedicate the Marshall corridor in the Pentagon - Approved.

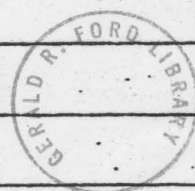

- Participate in Secretary Rumsfeld's event on the Mall on May 10 which is the kick-off for Armed Forces Day week.
- Chair another Defense budget meeting with key government officials to review Congressional actions.
- Take a one-hour flight on a large command and control aircraft located at Andrews Air Force Base.
- Participate in a Service Academy graduation on June 2. This is the same day as Juan Carlos' visit and, if we are not able to change the arrival ceremony from 10:30 to 12:30 p.m., we would not be able to do it. The only Academy logical in terms of time and travel is the Naval Academy.

Provided there is interest in these events, we will pursue staff comment, assign dates, and resubmit them to you for final action.



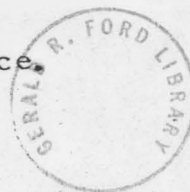

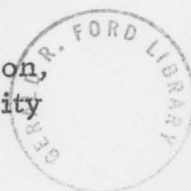
