SUBJECT: SENIOR STAFF MEETING



I have comments on two items which came up at this morning's meeting:

1. Tax Withholding Rates - If the law clearly requires an increase in withholding rates immediately because of Congressional inaction, then any public stand by the President should deal squarely with this fact. I do not believe the Executive Branch should be in the position of even a technical violation of law, simply because of Congressional incompetence.

I think the President should deal with this issue in a straightforward, direct manner by stating that the law will be enforced, that Congressional delay has resulted in a tax increase, and that Congress is refusing to even consider the additional tax cuts proposed by the President.

2. Clarence Kelley - Based on my past dealings with the Justice Department, I suspect that much of this problem is the result of the delays in their ability to make decisions. According to the Washington Post, the staff recommendation on Kelley was sent to the Attorney General three weeks ago, but there still has not been a decision.

I recommend that you or Jim Cavanaugh personally get involved; otherwise, there may be additional delays which will keep this very damaging story running. As you know, one of the major Carter attacks on the President has to do with morality in the Executive Branch of government, and the FBI situation is inevitably cited

in their statements. We should nail this one down very quickly, take definitive action, and then stand by it. Don't let this one fester.
