I told Rog Morton about Tom Kleppe's suggestion that the President be involved in the Interior Department announcement of the new strip mining regulation.

Rog thinks it would be "raw politics" for the President to be involved, since Presidents aren't normally involved in the issuing of regulations. Also, this issue does not cut to our favor, and therefore the President should avoid personal involvement.

I've checked independently within the Administration and concur with Rog's recommendation that the President not do this event.
