## NOTICE TO THE PRESS

The President has signed H.R. 14012 -- the Legislative Branch Appropriations Act, 1975 -- which appropriates \$708,275, 650 for the activities of the Congress and Legislative Branch agencies for fiscal year 1975.

In total, the 1975 bill provides \$46.9 million more than did the 1974 bill. The major increases and decreases follow:

(in millions of dollars) House of Representatives..... 11.0 -- reflects increased costs for Federal contributions to employee health insurance premiums, full year funding of increased pay costs, and expansion of House and Senate staff and services. Joint items..... -- reflects increased costs for reimbursement to to the U.S. Postal Service for official mail services and certain staff expansions. Office of Technology Assessment.....+ -- reflects increased funding necessary for the first full year operation of this new office. Architect of the Capitol..... -- decrease due to the completion in fiscal year 1974 of funding for construction of the New Senate Office Building extension.
