NOTICE TO THE PRESS

The President today has announced his intention to appoint Senator John G. Tower and Mr. Owen K. Garriott to serve as Members of the U.S. Delegation to the Farnborough International Air Show in Farnborough, England, September 2 through 8, 1974.

The Farnborough Air Show is a commercial exposition of modern aircraft. This is the first time that foreign delegations have been invited to attend this air show which previously has been a domestic event.

Senator Tower is the second ranking Republican on the Senate Committee on Armed Services and the ranking Republican on the Joint Committee on Defense Production. Mr. Garriott is Deputy Director for Science and Applications, of the National Aeronautics, of the National Aeronautics and Space Administration.
