NOTICE TO THE PRESS

The President today announced the appointment of Roman Pucinski, of Chicago, Illinois, to be a Member of the National Advisory Council on Vocational Education, for the remainder of a term which expires January 17, 1976. He succeeds Arthur M. Lee who was appointed February 26, 1973, and has resigned effective today.

Mr. Pucinski is presently an Alderman for the 41st Ward of Chicago. He served in the United States Congress from January of 1959 to January of 1973. Prior to his election to Congress, he served as a staff reporter and writer for the Chicago Sun Times from 1938 to 1958.

He was born on May 13, 1919, in Chicago, Illinois and attended Northwestern University and John Marshal Law School.

He is married to the former Aurelia Bordin and they have two children. They reside in Chicago, Illinois.
