## THE WHITE HOUSE

The President today announced that he has reappointed Clyde S. DuPont of Alexandria, Virginia, to be a Commissioner of the Postal Rate Commission.

From 1969 to October, 1974, Mr. DuPont was Minority Counsel for the Post Office and Civil Service Committee after having served as a Professional Staff Member of the Judiciary Committee from 1967 to 1968. In 1964 he was named Legislative Assistant to Senator Hiram L. Fong, serving until 1967.

He was born on December 28, 1933, in Waialua, Hawaii. He received his B.S. degree from Brigham Young University in 1959 and his J.D. degree from George Washington University Law School in February, 1963. He served as a Staff Sergeant in the United States Air Force from 1952 to 1956. He is a member of the District of Columbia Bar Association.

He is married to the former Joan Kimball and they have three children. They reside in Alexandria, Virginia.
