The President today announced his intention to nominate Jack J. Valenti, of Houston, Texas, to be a Member of the Board of Directors of the Corporation for Public Broadcasting for the remainder of a term expiring March 26, 1976. He succeeds Irving Kristol.

Mr. Valenti is currently President of the Motion Picture Association of America, Inc. and the Association of Motion Picture and Television Producers, Inc. From November of 1963, to June of 1966, Mr. Valenti served as Special Assistant to the President in the Johnson Administration.

Mr. Valenti was born on September 5, 1921, in Houston, Texas, and received his B.A. degree from the University of Houston in 1946. He received his M.B.A. degree from Harvard University Graduate School of Business in 1948.

He is married to the former Mary Margaret Wiley and they have three children. They reside in Washington, D. C.
