I have the honor to submit for your consideration a proposed supplemental appropriation for the fiscal year 1975 in the amount of \$17,342,000 for the Department of State, as follows:

INTERNATIONAL ORGANIZATIONS AND CONFERENCES

International Commission of Control and Supervision

For an additional amount for "International Commission of Control and Supervision", \$17,342,000: Provided, That this appropriation shall not be available for obligation except upon enactment into law of authorizing legislation.

The proposed supplemental appropriation will provide additional contributions to the International Commission of Control and Supervision in Vietnam for vital logistical operations. This proposal will not increase currently estimated 1975 budget outlays.

I have carefully reviewed the proposal for appropriations contained in this document and am satisfied that this request is necessary at this time. I recommend, therefore, that this proposal be transmitted to the Congress.
