NOTICE TO THE PRESS

The President has signed S. 194--which authorizes the Secretary of the Interior to convey certain lands to the City of Anchorage, Alaska.

The President has signed S. 184--which authorizes the Secretary of the Interior to convey to the Gospel Missionary Union all right, title, and interest of the United States in certain land in Juneau, Alaska.

The President has signed S. 3489, which authorizes an exchange between the U.S. Forest Service and the Town of Jackson of lands adjacent to the Teton National Forest in the State of Wyoming.

The President has signed S. 3518 which quiets title with respect to 9,000 to 10.000 acres of land in Nevada.

The President has signed S. 2594 - Relief of Jan Sejna, which waives certain provisions of the Immigration and Nationality Act to enable beneficiary to be naturalized.

The President has signed H.R. 3538 - for the relief of Selmer Amundson, which waives the applicable statute of limitation provision of the Social Security Act in order to authorize the crediting for social security disability purposes of Selmer Amundson's self-employment income for 1964 through 1966; and amends the Act to permit social security coverage of policemen and firemen in Montana.

The President has signed S. 2125--which authorizes relinquishment of the reversionary interest in approximately one acre of land to the city of Albuquerque, New Mexico.

The President has signed S. 2838--for the relief of Michael D. Manemann--in accordance with the conclusions of the Court of Claims, this bill authorizes and directs the payment of \$27,000 to Michael D. Manemann, a former military dependent, in full satisfaction of his claims against the United States arising from the negligent actions of U. S. Air Force personnel in failing to diagnose the existence of tuberculosis.
