NOTICE TO THE PRESS

The President today appointed Major General Francis Koisch of Fort Worth, Texas, as Federal Representative to the Red River Compact negotiations. The States included in the negotiations are Arkansas, Louisiana, Oklahoma, and Texas.

The President today announced his intention to nominate George J. Long of Fern Creek, Kentucky, for reappointment as United States Attorney for the Western District of Kentucky. He is now serving in this office under an appointment which expired on October 14, 1974.
