NOTICE TO THE PRESS

The President today announced his intention to nominate Ramon M. Child, of Salt Lake City, Utah, to be a United States Attorney for the District of Utah for a term of four years. He will succeed the late C. Nelson Day.

Mr. Child, from 1961 to 1974, was with the firm of Ray, Quinney and Nebeker and since 1974, has engaged in the private practice of law.

The President today announced his intention to nominate John E. Clark, of San Antonio, Texas, to be United States Attorney for the Western District of Texas for a term of four years. He will succeed William S. Sessions who has resigned.

Since 1971, Mr. Clark has been First Assistant United States Attorney for the Western District of Texas.

The President today announced his intention to nominate Ralph B. Guy, of Dearborn, Michigan, for reappointment as United States Attorney for the Eastern District of Michigan for a term of four years. He was appointed on December 20, 1970.
