Salaries and Expenses

For an additional amount for "Salaries and expenses", \$13,621,000.

This request will provide funds to issue and process the additional checks for 1974 income tax rebates and payments to recipients of certain retirement and survivor benefits, as required by Public Law 94-12, and for unforeseen increases in the number of checks issued and processed for tax refunds and other purposes.

Special Payment to Recipients of Certain Retirement and Survivor Benefits

For "Special Payment to Recipients of Certain Retirement and Survivor Benefits", \$1,750,000,000 to remain available until December 31, 1975.

This request will provide funds for the one-time payments to recipients of certain retirement and survivor benefits as required by Public Law 94-12.

Fishermen's Protective Fund

For payment to the "Fishermen's Protective Fund", in accordance with section 5 of Public Law 92-569 approved October 26, 1972, \$3,000,000, to remain available until expended.

This request will replenish funds used to reimburse owners of vessels for the amounts of fines, fees, and other direct charges which they paid to a foreign country to secure the release of their vessels and crews.
