pool report or president ford's return flight to washington april 19, 1975

it was an unefentful, though bumpy, 63-minute flight, landing at 12.29 in the rain at andrews. the president went to helicopter under umbrella.

nessen did not come back during flight; neither did president.

no manifest was made available, but pool saw sen. edward m.

kennedy leave plane by front door shortly after president. kennedy told
pool he and president had talked enroute about the celebration
in massachuesetts, and that mr. ford had been impressed by the warmth
of the greeting he received and by the size of the crowds. kennedy said
the president was especially impressed by the KKKK beauty of old north
church.

add: kennedy met at airport by son teddy, jr. together senator and son returned from terminal adross tarmac through rain to climb front steps into air force one, kennedy apparently giving his son a tour. they were on board seven minutes, leaving by front steps and hetting into a car parked there. the boy carried a welcome aboard air force one booklet.
