Later, at Schloss Klessheim. Mr. Ford was asked -- did you hart yourself? He should his head no, and said "I lost my heel". Are you still walking on it he was asked. 'Ch, no, I changed shoes.' Mr. Ford was wearing black tassled loafers. During a photo opportunity at Schloss Klessheim Mrs. Ford said jokingly that the heel said 'No skie on it". Hushen says the incident tore the heal completely off and that it was later found on the ramp. Asked if Ford suffered any minor abrasions, Hushen checked with Dr. Lukash who explained that he had not had a chance to see the President yet.
