From Palmer House to McCormick Place, Chicago

The President emerged from the Palmer House on the State Street side at about 9:20 a.m. A crowd of several hundred people was waiting. The motorcade moved along Monroe Street past Michigan Avenue to Lake Shore Drive, where it turned right and traveled quickly to McCormick Place along a roadway that had been pretty well cleared of traffic. Mr. Ford arrived at McCormick Place about 9:30 a.m.

There were only a few people greeting President Ford along the way. Most appeared to be citizens who had gotten out of their automobiles after being halted by traffic police to permit the President's passage. There were no halts and no incidents.
