The President was in the Oval Office at 7:40 a.m. today and met with members of his staff during the morning.

At 11:00 a.m., he will hold a Cabinet Meeting in the Cabinet Room. Topics included energy, legislative plans, and Turkish aid. (Press Secretary Ron Nessen will provide details following the meeting--either in a briefing or a posting.)

At 2:00 p.m., the President will meet with United Nations Ambassador Daniel P. Moynihan. This is the first private meeting the two have had since Ambassador Moynihan was appointed on June 10, 1975.

Announcements

The President has announced his intention to nominate Arthur C. Neilson, Jr. of Winnetka, Illinois, and George H. Gallup of Princeton, New Jersey, as members of the United States Advisory Commission on Information.

The President has signed a proclamation on Citizenship Day and Constitution Day.
