Sir:

I have the honor to submit for your consideration proposed supplemental appropriations in the amount of \$449,400,000 for fiscal year 1976 and \$123,300,000 for the transition quarter for the Veterans Administration, as follows:

VETERANS ADMINISTRATION

Compensation and Pensions

For an additional amount for "Compensation and pensions", \$449,400,000.

For an additional amount for "Compensation and pensions", for the period July 1, 1976, through September 30, 1976, \$123,300,000.

This supplemental would provide funding to meet the higher benefit payments for veteran and survivor compensation recipients provided under P.L. 94-71 which became effective August 1, 1975.

I have carefully reviewed this budget request and I am satisfied that it is necessary at this time. I recommend therefore, that this request be transmitted to the Congress.
