Among the groups greeting the President was the Comprehensive Marching Band of Chicopee, Massachusetts.

The room upstairs is the Springfield East and West rooms with no decorations -- 14 round tables with eight editors, publishers and reporters to a table. When we entered, they were just sitting around waiting for the President to arrive. Several editors asked whether a White House pool would be admitted and almost defensively said that it was no ruling of theirs that kept the White House press corps out.

The President will speak from a simple lectern.
