NOTICE TO THE PRESS

The Office of the Press Secretary in Washington has made the following releases Friday, November 14:

1. The President today announced his intention to nominate Andrew Steigman, of Bethesda, Maryland, to be Ambassador to Sao Tome and to Principe.
2. The President today announced his intention to nominate three persons to be members of the Board of Directors of the Inter-American Foundation. They are William Mailliard, of San Francisco, California; John Richardson of McLean, Virginia; and, William D. Rogers of Great Falls, Virginia.
3. The President has sent to the President of the Senate and to the Speaker of the House a supplemental budget request for \$385,168 for fiscal 1976, and \$710 for the Transition Quarter for the Legislative Branch.
4. The President has signed four bills. They are S. 1649, Gifts for the National Arboretum; S. 896, Volunteers in the Parks Program; H. R. 6334, Peace Corps Authorization for Fiscal 1976 and the transition quarter; and S. 24, Patent Cooperation Treaty.
